**Reflection on Acts 8:26-40:** But Philip heard the voice of the Holy Spirit speak a different answer to the man's question. "What is to prevent me from being baptized?" asked the eunuch. "Absolutely nothing," whispered the Spirit. "Absolutely nothing." So the eunuch commanded the chariot to stop, and he was baptized right on the spot. Walls of prejudice and prohibition that had stood for generations can tumbling, blown down by the breath of God's Holy Spirit, and another man who felt lost and humiliated was found and restored in the wideness of God's grace in Jesus Christ.


